Facility Rules & Info

- Please arrive early to walk & potty your dog BEFORE you enter the building! (FSIC: There are grassy areas in front of the building as well as a large gravel parking lot behind the building to walk dogs; please do not allow dogs on adjacent business properties!; KEYMAR you may walk potty dogs in grass field around the building, please stay out of the yard of the home and out of the horse fields) You MUST pick up after your dog! Anyone found not picking up after their dog, or if we receive complaints about our students you will be asked to leave and not return. This is non-negotiable.
- Do NOT allow dogs to potty in the building or the training areas! You MUST
 watch your dog closely, if you think your dog needs to potty please excuse
 yourself to get the dog outside.
- There will be a \$25 Fee if your dog potty's ON the Equipment- Please do not allow dogs to "mark" territory on our equipment or on the building!
- There will be a "waiting' area while not training in the ring, please bring a tarp, matt or blanket to set your crate & or chair on while waiting, so as to protect the turf at FSIC. This is a must.
- Foundations & Agility Students are expected to bring crates for their dogs to class
 we WILL be doing exercises and/or walking courses without the dogs, so securing them properly is necessary. A soft lightweight crate is great for this.
 Tying a dog is not acceptable.
- FSIC: The Classroom is located upstairs of the building (take the staircase on the right as you enter the main entrance), turn left at top of stairs, go back to the "Strike Zone batting cage" area where the classroom will be. ** OR Enter through the side door on the left of the building at the parking lot, immediately inside door will be stairs at the top turn to the right down the hall where the classroom is. Please keep gate closed to the classroom at all times. **An elevator is available on the left side entrance of the building, please be care with dogs and the elevator.

- KEYMAR: This is a private Equestrian property please do not drive or park in the grass or allow dogs to potty in the yard of the home; there are plenty of areas between the barns to potty/walk dogs. Parking is on the gravel areas alongside the buildings. When the Middle doors to the barn are open (opposite the people door) you may walk straight through the barn to the arena, otherwise please do not go through the barn if the doors are closed. The Indoor Arena is the large building behind the main barn, entry is also through the white gate on the right side of the barn to go up to the building. Please do not walk through the horse field, allow dogs to bark at horses or pet the horses.
- If there is a class ongoing when you arrive, please wait in the hall or outside the building at Keymar until the current class is dismissed; and/or check with Mel to be sure there is room to set up.
- Classes will start promptly so please be on time.
- If you have questions for Mel, please wait until class is dismissed or the start of the next class.
- Please limit dogs to the classroom area; dogs should not be exploring other areas of the buildings, particularly the soccer fields or horse barns, nor should dogs be let loose to run in the training areas unless they are participating in the lesson.

MSQUARED POLICIES/PROCEDURES

<u>Inclement Weather Policy:</u> Snow, heat, or other potentially hazardous weather or emergency situations may necessitate cancellations. Students should use their best judgment regarding their safety and travel arrangements. Reasonable effort will be made by MSquared staff to notify class members regarding any cancellation. If in doubt, please email or text the Melinda. Classes which are cancelled due to weather and/or emergencies will be added to the end of the session or rescheduled to a different date.

- Students are responsible for attending all classes; 24 hour cancellation policy as stated below. Special arrangements may be considered for specific circumstances.
- If class is canceled due to weather or other, MSquared Staff will do their best to notify all students at least 2 hours in advance. Make Up Classes will be added to the end of the Session or rescheduled to a different date if canceled by MSquared.

- Please clean up after your dog.
- 24 Hour cancellation notice is required to reschedule private or group lessons; if you have not paid but have a spot reserved, you will still owe payment for that class or lesson. If any lesson group or private is canceled within the 24 hour period you may keep your class credit and reschedule or drop in to another class depending on availability. No shows will be charged as if attending class. 24 hour cancelation must be in writing via email to MSquared staff.
- Pre-Paid packages (group & privates) must be scheduled/used within 60 days from date of purchase; No refunds.
- Drop Ins are on a limited basis, check email for availability. Regular drop in's may be reserved.
- Discounts given for multiple dogs- 10% off a total package of lessons.
- We love Referrals! For every referral that purchases any lesson package you get 1 Free group class or 30 minute private lesson!
- Students are expected to help set up/take down equipment as needed,
- Be polite and nice to your dogs! No harsh corrections or loud abusive behavior will be tolerated.
- Bring your smile and your happy can-do attitude to class!

Please come prepared to class with the following:

- 5-6-foot leash with a handle (NO Flexi leads, E Collars, Choke or Prong collars)
- 2 types of Yummy super good high value treats (something you don't feed daily is ideal)
- A Favorite toy, tug toys are ideal.
- Poop bags for cleanup.
- Comfortable shoes you can move easily in, and run in, no sandals please.
- A yoga matt if available or a dog bed like a lightweight crate matt (if you don't have this, I
 will have extra, but you will want a yoga matt or crate matt for practice at home) **this is for

- A positive attitude and your best happy voice!
- Puppy Class Bring a crate to first 2 classes, preferably hard crate w/door.
